Climate.

Conditions vary greatly depending on altitude and local topography. The climate on the Montreux Riviera or in Ticino, for example, is virtually Mediterranean, while the country's highest peaks – including 48 mountains above 4,000 metres – are capped with snow and ice year-round. We can advise on suitable clothing for different itineraries and activities. For winter visits, note that even historic hotels and other buildings are well insulated and cosy.

Money.

Currency is the Swiss franc (CHF), one of the most stable in the world; as you would expect from one of the world's leading financial centres, money transactions are smooth and straightforward. ATMs accept cards from around the world, but it is advisable to check with the card issuer before travel. Money can be changed widely, credit cards are accepted virtually everywhere. A service charge is normally included in restaurant and hotel bills and in taxi fares. Tips are not expected, but appreciated.

Value added tax.

The Swiss government is known for its business-friendly approach; for example, VAT rates are the lowest in Europe at 8 %. Usually, foreign companies can reclaim all VAT paid in Switzerland direct from the Swiss Federal Tax Administration (FTA), quickly and easily. We'll show you how.
